Bookbag is a children's book gifting initiative established by picturebook maker and creator of the Henry Hugglemonster series, **Niamh Sharkey**, during her term as Laureate na nÓg (2012–2014)

Aimed at schools which may not have the necessary resources to fund books for a school library, the Bookbag project builds a buzz around reading and encourages a whole-school reading culture, which should be sustainable beyond the duration of the project.

Bookbag ensures that every child in the school has access to a selection of books in their school library. The books gifted are chosen carefully: they are visually striking, entertaining, funny and engaging; the type of book that we hope will draw in a child who does not already think of themselves as a reader.
